Please be advised of the following contest rules for Butterfly Day April 17th 2010:

- (1) All butterflies will be done in a "free form" manner. No patterns will be provided. The artwork should be between 3" x 5" to 8 1/2" x 11".
- (2) There are two categories: Fantasy & Realistic.
- (3) Judging criteria: Originality, Elements of Art, Execution of Theme Chosen, Detail, Overall Appearance, and Principles of Design. If computer generated please specify on form.
- (4) Suggested materials: pencil color, watercolor pencil, marker, soft pastel, oil pastel, pen & ink, pencil, watercolor, acrylic paint, crayon.
- (5) All entries must be laminated with strings attached for hanging.
- (6) Identification tags must be filled out completely in order to be judged. Please print information. Tags are included in this mailing.
- (7) Teachers in grades 1st-12th select the top five entries from their classrooms and place in an envelope. These entries will be juried together and ribbons will be awarded. Kindergarten and pre-school students are welcome to participate but will not be judged. We have a "special education" award in each division. Please indicate on the ID Tag.

PLEASE NOTE: Due to laminating cost, you have the choice to either laminate all entries to be displayed or just the top five in each category to be judged and displayed. We welcome any and all entries, but they must be tied on fencing (provided by EmilyAnn) and brought to the Theatre by April 2nd.

- (8) All entries will receive a participation award and it can be downloaded electronically for your school to duplicate.
- (9) Best of show and 1st place winners will become the property of the EmilyAnn Theatre & Gardens.
